

ROADMAP OF COLLABORATIVE PROCESS

Sequence of probable agendas for group meetings:

- **First Group Meeting:** Introduction, signing collaborative participation agreement and then statements of interests and goals for the collaborative process and for resolution, scheduling of future meetings and discussion of timing for filing any dissolution procedural documents. “Walk around the Estate,” agree on schedule for sharing documents and information and who is assigned to provide, attend to temporary needs, including financial and parenting, and any urgent matters, and plan agenda for Second Group Meeting.

- **Second and Subsequent Group Meetings:** Exchange information, bring in neutrals as needed, identify and explore all available options for resolution and discuss consequences, if any, of each. Negotiate/compromise terms of settlement agreement, assign responsibility for preparation of drafting of settlement agreement and other documents, if any. Plan agenda for subsequent meetings.

- **Final Group Meeting:** Review and sign dissolution agreement and procedural dissolution document(s), review and evaluate collaborative process, and discuss likely future “road bumps” and how they will be addressed.
